**ORDER**

**Subject:-** Regulation on movement of passengers from islands to mainland –  
Regarding.

Considering the prevailing situation arising out of the increase in number of nCOVID19 cases in the country and keeping the core objective of ensuring the well-being and safety of the islanders especially those who have to travel to mainland due to essential and urgent works, Lakshadweep Administration has decided that it is mandatory for every passenger (to board on ship) to have urgency certificate, to be issued by the Deputy Collector or SDO of the respective islands. Without the urgency certificate, no one will be allowed to board any ship with immediate effect until further order. And for all the consequent cancellations, 100 percent refund will be ensured as soon as possible. For any query, DC/SDO of the respective island may be contacted.
